Environmental policy

Introduction and aim

Revolution is a business, operating from a site in Broadstairs. We provide a facility for people of all ages to practice sports such as Skateboarding, Inline Skating, BMX biking and Climbing. It is our aim to comply with legislation and other requirements, continue to reduce the environmental impacts of our business and operate in an environmentally responsible manner. Objectives

During 2013, we aim to:

- reduce electricity consumption within the Skatepark and Climbing Centre
- maintain and optimise our recycling of materials generated within our business
- inform all customers and suppliers of our commitment to reducing our environmental impact

Targets

To achieve our aims, we have set ourselves the following targets:

- inform all customers and suppliers about our environmental policy by June 2013 and, thereafter, all new customers and suppliers
- define good practice for energy consumption, ensure all employees receive training in good housekeeping by June 2013 and incorporate this training into the induction programme for new starters
- introduce an power management system to reduce the amount of electricity being consumed by June 2013
- evaluate the costs and benefits of converting to an alternate source of energy by October 2013

Monitoring and auditing

Progress against these objectives will be monitored through monthly management meetings.
